VII. REMARKS FROM THE BOARD PRESIDENT

Mrs. Logan-Leach apologized for the delay in the starting of tonight's meeting, but the Board was conducting Donaldson Hearings tonight.

She also indicated that she recently attended an event at Café Vivace for the League of Excellence.

Mrs. Logan-Leach and Mrs. Belin-Pyles recently attended a workshop on shared services. There were districts from all over the state where shared services was hi-lighted.

Mrs. Campbell moved to approve the float rental, seconded by Mr. Abdul-Haqq. The motion failed, on a roll-call vote with seven members opposed.

Ms. Barksdale expressed concern that the Board just received the FY10-11 12 month appointments for the agenda.

Mrs. Belin-Pyles indicated that approval is needed so that staff may be paid on July 15, 2010.

The motion carried, on a roll-call vote, with Ms. Barksdale was in favor of Items A-R, Y, Z, Aa and abstained on Items T & X, Mrs. Campbell, Mrs. Edwards, Mrs. Hernandez in favor of all, but opposed Item T, Mrs. Peterson in favor of all, but abstained on Item A-PESG-022, PEAC-075, and Item X-PEAC-75, Mr. Abdul-Haqq in favor of all, but abstained on Item T and opposed Item X-PASA-047. Mrs. Logan-Leach in favor of all, abstained on Item A-PEAT-427 and opposed Item T.

Pursuant to the federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act of 2001, public schools in the state of New Jersey are required to annually assess the English language proficiency of their English Language Learners (ELLs) in kindergarten through grade 12 using a standards-based instrument that is common throughout the state. In response to this mandate, the New Jersey State Department of Education adopted the ACCESS for ELLs developed by the WIDA Consortium. For this school year, the ACCESS for ELLs will be administered to over 1, 200 students during the months of March and April 2010.

The data must be analyzed in order to properly place Bilingual students in September 2010. Responsibilities include: separation of ACCESS Test Reports by school and grade; Preparation of school student rosters, teacher reports and parent reports; Reproduction of school reports and placed into binders for each school. Data will be shared with Bilingual Staff as well as Administrators.

With a fast growing Spanish speaking community in Plainfield, there is an increased need for district and school personnel to send written notices, letters, and other important information to parents in their native language (Spanish). As well there is a need for staff to conduct home visitations to inform parents of student services and academic and behavior status of students. A number of events such as: Town-Hall meetings, BOE meetings, Back to School Night conferences and parent-teacher conferences etc. have been scheduled for the 2009-2010 school year which will require the presence of an oral translator to assist with the Spanish speaking community members who attend these events. The NCLB legislation provide districts with funding

(Title II) to provide parents with information pertaining to their children's education in their native language (Spanish).

- A list of instructional materials, including various levels of test at each grade;
- Benchmark assessments; and
- Modifications for special education students for English language learners in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:15 and for gifted students.
