

Bylaw

PUBLIC STATEMENTS

Only the Board President shall authorize or make statements of official board positions.

No other member of the Board of Education individually will speak for, or in the name of, the full board unless by explicit direction of the Board. Board members should emphasize that they can only speak as individual board members unless empowered by the Board to speak for it. If letters are written to government officials or newspapers, an individual board member should state that his/her opinions do not represent the position of the Board.
