



Plainfield Public Schools Security Procedure for Athletic Events

The Plainfield Public Schools will conduct the following, procedure to provide security enhancements to their athletic facilities. Earlier this year, the NFL instituted this policy as a result of the Boston Marathon bombing. The procedure limits the size and types of bags that may be brought into the stadium or similar events. Ultimately, this will provide a safer and more secure environment to fans, guests, and players.

It is recommended that small clutch bags approximately the size of a hand, with or without a handle or strap, can be taken into the stadium with one of the clear plastic bag options.

Special exceptions may be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at a gate designated for this purpose.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS fans will be allowed to carry into the stadium include clear plastic, vinyl or PVC bags, packages, or containers, binoculars, cameras, and smartphones.

PROHIBITED BAGS include oversized purses or pocketbooks, coolers, backpacks, large sacks and/or luggage.

PROHIBITED ITEMS include alcoholic beverages, balloons, balls, bottles, coolers, fireworks, laser pointers, noisemaking devices, pets, weapons, and other items deemed dangerous and/or inappropriate.
