Frequently Asked Questions

1. What if I do not know what grade I will be teaching next year?

We suggest you speak with your principal prior to registration and let him/her know that you are furthering your education this summer and would like to know this information since the workshops are based on the grade band.

2. What building will the workshops be held in?

We are currently confirming the logistics for the session. Information will be provided once all workshop sites have been secured.

3. Why do I need to provide an alternate email address?

In some cases, school or district firewalls block group emails that may contain important information related to the workshops.

4. What time do the workshops actually start?

Check-in will begin at 8:30 A.M. the first day of the workshop. The sessions will begin promptly at 9:00 A.M. and will end promptly at 3:00 P.M. each day.

5. What if I need to miss part of the institute?

You will not want to miss any of these engaging and informative sessions. However, if you cannot avoid a conflict or if an emergency arises, please inform your facilitator prior to your departure. Missing any part of the session for any reason, including tardiness, will negate eligibility for Professional Development Hours.

6. What do I wear?

Appropriate attire is business casual. Remember, however, that most schools are air-conditioned, but some might not be running in the summer. Therefore, temperatures inside host schools can range from extremely warm to quite cold, so it might be advisable to dress in layers no matter what the temperature is outside.

7. What do I need to bring?

You should bring a writing utensil, paper for notes, and a laptop.

8. Will food be provided?

Food is not being provided. You may bring your own snacks and water if desired. School vending machines which might be available are frequently not stocked over the summer. Lunch will be on your own.

9. May we register all of our teachers for an institute?

This year's workshops are by grade band. Schools can select and register a teacher for each grade level. Principals, please contact the Elementary Office if you need additional assistance or have questions.
