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REMINDERS:

Below are a few reminders that will assist us in ensuring a positive school year for our children. Please make sure your child:

1. Attends school daily and arrives on time
2. Completes all homework assignments given by teachers
3. Reads daily
4. **Wear Uniforms Daily-We do not have DRESS Down Fridays. Notification will be given when there is a change in dress code**

Arrival: All children must enter the building through the front doors and meet in the gym or the cafeteria for breakfast. Students should arrive by 8:00 AM and are marked late after 8:10 AM. **NO STUDENT SHOULD ARRIVE BEFORE 8:00 AM** unless they are participating in the breakfast program. Breakfast is served free of charge to all students from 7:30 AM until 7:55 AM. Please do not drop your child off before 7:30 AM, as there is no adult supervision.

Parents are not allowed to walk students to class in the morning. Students will be dismissed from the gym in the morning. **Students arriving after 8:09 AM must receive a late pass from the office.**
