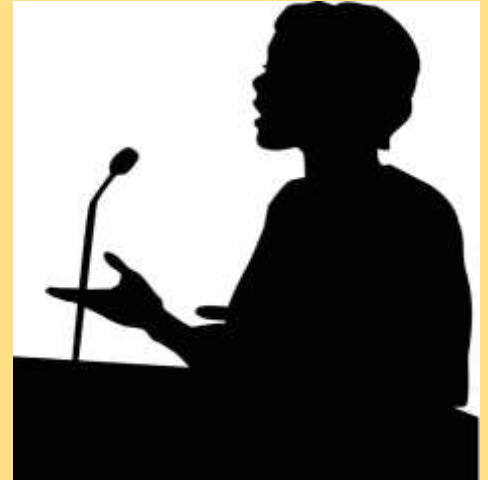

Keys to teaching children conflict resolutions:

1. Help them identify their emotions
2. Help them learn how to express emotions in positive ways (talking, drawing, listening to music, etc.)
3. Children must learn to recognize *other people's* emotions/feelings
4. You are your child's biggest ROLE MODEL, set an example and enforce limits with them.
5. Take a stand against physical aggression and name-calling. *Think of other ways to solve problems.*

*Very important for a child to exercise choice and decision-making power over their own behavior. You are there to help *guide* them.
