

Ronald E. Bolandi was Montclair Public Schools Interim Superintendent. Prior to being in Montclair he was Interim Superintendent in Bedminster Public Schools, and, from 2011 to 2013, served as Interim Superintendent of the Kearny Public Schools. Before that, he was Interim Superintendent of Edison Township Public Schools, one of the largest K-12 school districts in the state with 15,000 students.

Ron Bolandi was the Superintendent in the East Windsor Regional School District from 2004-2010 before officially retiring. He has also held positions as Superintendent in Piscataway, Chester, and Winslow townships and as Assistant Superintendent in Middletown and Middlesex Borough.

During his tenure in Montclair, he has kept all work focused on students. Initiatives begun in programming, tutoring, curriculum, administrative and more have a focal point of improving the achievement (learning) gap. He has extensive experience in finance, supervising budgets in excess of \$90 million and construction projects totaling \$250 million. In the area of evaluation and assessment, he has worked with staff to develop state-of-the-art programs that assist and improve direct instruction to enhance student achievement. In Piscataway, in conjunction with the teachers' association, he developed a state recognized model staff development program which was replicated in East Windsor Regional School District.
