

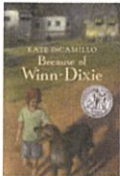
# 95th Saturday Reunion

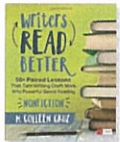
**October 20th, 2018** 9:00am - 3:00pm

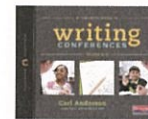
## Featured Presenters
