

Air Quality Preparations



In-door air quality test performed in all buildings.

Vents cleaned in all buildings.

Window hardware repaired throughout the District.

Outside vendor to install air purification systems to improve air quality in all campuses.





Restrooms



"Wash Your Hands" signage posted in each restroom.

Bathrooms are checked hourly for sanitation and cleaning.

Soap dispensers in each restroom.

Bathroom alerts & no-mask hotline for all employees.

Preventative Measures

Training: cleaning & disinfecting protocols for all maintanence staff.



Nurses have been trained to identify COVID symptoms for students and staff.



Nurse Supervisor completed contact-tracing protocols for all employees.



If a student shows any COVID-19 symptoms, child will be isolated until parent/guardian arrives for pick up.



Collaborating constantly with the Plainfield Health Officer on all COVID-19 Updates.



Free Flu Clinics for employees through November 11th.

Only 50 % of students attend Brick and Mortar each day for ½ day

teacher in the afternoon












IN THE AFTERNOON, THE STUDENTS WILL ENGAGE WITH ASYNCHRONOUS ASSIGNMENTS





Parent Responsibilities: BEFORE SENDING YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL

Attestation Form

Verify that your child does not have any COVID symptoms

Verify that your child has not been exposed to COVID

If your child has any symptoms or has been exposed, please keep your child home

Completed DAILY electronically

Temperatur e Check

Ensure that your child does not have a fever

If your child has a temperature of above 100.0 keep your child home for the day

Contact your child's school before sending your child back to school

Face Covering

All students must wear a face covering approved by the CDC

Gaiters are not approved

Help your child build mask endurance Contact your building principal if your child cannot wear a face covering

Supplies

Charged device

Water bottle

Pencils, pens, etc. (children should not share objects with each other)



Face Coverings

Approved: Non-distracting face masks.





• NOT Approved: Distracting, gaiter or masks with valves





When do I keep my child home from school?

- If you have answered YES to any of the questions from the Attestation Form, please contact your school's nurse and healthcare provider and keep your child home
- If your child has "two" COVID related symptoms, please keep your child home, contact your school nurse and healthcare provider
- If your child is home sick or in quarantine, they can log in to their class for livestreaming if they feel good enough to participate in virtual learning & attendance will count for the day
- If your child has been exposed to COVID (even if your child does not exhibit any symptoms), please follow the quarantine protocols
 - Contact your child's nurse/principal for further questions
- If your child has traveled outside of NJ to any of the states and/or countries as determined by Governor Murphy, please follow the quarantine protocols
