

# Plainfield public schools pre-k registration now open

The Pre-kindergarten application period is now open for Plainfield children and families to apply for children who will be 3 or 4 by Oct. 1. Special registration sessions have been scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 20, Tuesday, Feb. 23 and Thursday, Feb. 25. It is recommended that parents do not bring the children to the registration process, since there may be a long waiting time.

The Plainfield Public Schools' Pre-K program is a nationally recognized program, approved by NJ State Department of Education, which emphasizes in developing the children's executive skills, initiative-taking, and problem solving. The children are immersed in dual language instruction in English and Spanish. The Pre-K program offers children six hours of free instruction with wrap-around hours available. Inclusion and self-contained settings are available for children who qualify for Special Education Services.

To register children, parents or guardians must bring their I.D. and the children's identification, proof of address, immunizations, current physical exam, and the child's original birth certificate on Saturday, Feb. 20, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., at 209 Berckman St. in Plainfield.
