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Dear Plainfield Public Schools Community:

This letter is to update the PPSD community of a possible workplace COVID-19 transmission which occurred last month. This crossed two departments, Transportation and Jefferson School. All parties were notified of being considered a close contact on January 16th. After consulting with the Plainfield Health Officer and our school physician, it was deemed there was no possibility of the second person infecting anyone else at the workplace as they were under self-quarantine during their contagious period and not on school grounds.

This letter also serves as a reminder that employees must truthfully attest to the below attestation document before reporting to any District building. Employees cannot report to work sick. Failure to honestly attest to the below statement will result in progressive discipline and can put our coworkers at risk. Please continue to report all COVID contacts to Contact Tracing:

ATTESTATION STATEMENT

- 1. Have you been diagnosed to have novel coronavirus (COVID-19) within the last 14 days?**
- 2. Within the last 14 days, to your knowledge, have you been in close contact with a person confirmed to have novel coronavirus (COVID-19)? (This means someone has been diagnosed with COVID-19 by a medical doctor).**
- 3. Do you have a fever of 100, cough, difficulty breathing, body aches, chills, or new loss of your sense of taste or smell?**
- 4. In the past 14 days, have you traveled to the states below or any other hot spot states as identified by the Governor Murphy:**

Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, California, Florida, Georgia, Guam, Hawaii, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, North Carolina, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Puerto Rico, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Virgin Islands, or Wisconsin?
