1. WHO IS SPONSORING THIS TESTING?

The Interfaith Urgent Care, a non-profit organization in NJ, in partnership with Plainfield Public Schools and the City of Plainfield.

2. WHOM IS THIS TEST FOR?

Plainfield Public Schools Employees, Parents and Students.

3. WHAT DAY IS THE TESTING?

Thursday, August 27, 2020

4. WHAT ARE THE TIMES FOR THE TESTING?

Testing starts at 11:00 a.m. until 7:00 pm.

5. WHAT WILL YOU BE TESTING FOR?

COVID-19 and COVID-19 Antibodies

6. HOW LONG IS THE PROCESS? HOW LONG SHOULD I EXPECT TO BE THERE?

Each test takes about 10 minutes.

7. WHERE IS THE TESTING?

8. DO I NEED IDENTIFICATION?

Yes, PHOTO ID is required.

9. DO I NEED MY INSURANCE CARD?

Yes, if you have insurance, please bring your card with you.

10. WHAT HAPPENS IF I DO NOT HAVE INSURANCE?

You will not be turned away. There is no charge. NO co pay. No deductible.

The testing is Free. If you have insurance, the insurance will cover the lab work. If not Interfaith Urgent Care will cover the cost.

11. DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR THE TEST?

No, you will not be charged. This is a free test offered under the Covid-19 Pandemic Cares Act; Interfaith Urgent Care covers the cost.

12. DO I HAVE TO SIGN-UP OR CAN I JUST WALK-IN TO TAKE THE TEST?

It is preferable if you register online at the link provided at www.plainfieldnj12.org. However, if you walk up you may have to wait your turn.

14. WHEN WILL I GET MY RESULTS?

Three (3) to Four (4) days after the test.

15. HOW WILL I GET MY RESULTS? BY MAIL? A PHONE CALL?

You will get a text and a phone call. Should you need written verification for travel or for school you may leave an email and a notice will be sent to you via email.

16. WHO WILL CALL ME?

A doctor from Interfaith Urgent Care will call you.

17. CAN MY CHILD SHOW UP FOR THE TEST ALONE?

No, a parent or guardian must accompany minors under 18 years of age.

18. IS THERE PARKING?

Yes, free parking is available at the testing site on Stelle Street

19. WHAT HAPPENS IF I AM LATE TO THE TEST?

No one will be turned away. You can still be tested.

20. WHAT HAPPENS IF I TEST POSITIVE?

You will get a call from the Interfaith Urgent Care doctors who will instruct you on what you need to do.

21. WHAT HAPPENS IF I DO NOT HAVE A DOCTOR?

You will get a list of doctors where you can get treatment.
